Introduction to Stewardship Project

One Fish... Two Fish... Red Fish... New Fish? is a skit written by instructors but performed by students.

Objectives

The goal of the skit was to inform students, patrons of Homer Lake, the campus, and the community about the threat of invasive species and encourage local advocacy.

Student Activities

Students created cue cards, provided costumes, and acted in the skit that was provided by instructors. The students performed the skit at various locations including Homer Lake (the community partner), in the classroom, and at Krannert Center for the Performing Arts on campus. The skit was videotaped and copies were distributed to students so that their parents could see what they had learned. In addition, students decorated a poster to display at the Stewardship Fair and the skit was played at the Fair for attendees to see.

Outcome/Impact of the Project

Students learned about the problems associated with invasive species and used that knowledge to educate the community and their families and encourage them to get involved locally.
